Bismillāhir-Rahmānir-Raheem

- 1. Whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth is exalting Allāh,1685 the Sovereign, the Pure, the Exalted in Might, the Wise. 1686
- 2. It is He who has sent among the unlettered [Arabs] a Messenger from themselves reciting to them His verses and purifying them and teaching them the Book [i.e., the Qur'an] and wisdom [i.e., the sunnah] - although they were before in clear error –
- 3. And [to] others of them who have not yet joined them. And He is the Exalted in Might, the Wise.
- 4. That is the bounty of Allah, which He gives to whom He wills, and Allāh is the possessor of great bounty.
- 5. The example of those who were entrusted with the Torah and then did not take it on1687 is like that of a donkey who carries volumes [of books]. 1688 Wretched is the example of the people who deny the signs of Allāh. And Allāh does not guide the wrongdoing people.

- 6. Say, "O you who are Jews, if you claim that you are allies of Allah, excluding the [other] people, then wish for death, if you should be truthful."
- 7. But they will not wish for it, ever, because of what their hands have put forth. And Allāh is Knowing of the wrongdoers.
- 8. Say, "Indeed, the death from which you flee - indeed, it will meet you. Then you will be returned to the Knower of the unseen and the witnessed, and He will inform you about what you used to do."
- 9. O you who have believed, when [the adhan] is called for the prayer on the day of Jumu'ah [Friday], then proceed to the remembrance of Allah and leave trade. That is better for you, if you only knew.
- 10. And when the prayer has been concluded, disperse within the land and seek from the bounty of Allāh, and remember Allāh often that you may succeed.
- 11. But [on one occasion] when they saw a transaction or a diversion, [O Muhammad], they rushed to it and left you standing. "What is with Allah is better than diversion and than a transaction. and Allāh is the best of providers."

- 1. When the hypocrites come to you, [O Muhammad], they say, "We testify that you are the Messenger of Allāh." And Allāh knows that you are His Messenger, and Allah testifies that the hypocrites are liars.
- 2. They have taken their oaths as a cover, so they averted [people] from the way of Allah. Indeed, it was evil that they were doing.
- 3. That is because they believed, and then they disbelieved; so their hearts were sealed over, and they do not understand.
- 4. And when you see them, their forms please you, and if they speak. you listen to their speech. [They are] as if they were pieces of wood propped up¹⁶⁹⁰ – they think that every shout is against them. They are the enemy, so beware of them. May Allāh destroy them; how are they deluded?
- 5. And when it is said to them, "Come, the Messenger of Allāh will ask forgiveness for you," they turn their heads aside and you see them evading while they are arrogant.
- 6. It is all the same for them whether you ask forgiveness for

them or do not ask forgiveness for them; never will Allāh forgive them. Indeed, Allāh does not guide the defiantly disobedient people.

- 7. They are the ones who say, "Do not spend on those who are with the Messenger of Allāh until they disband." And to Allāh belong the depositories of the heavens and the earth, but the hypocrites do not understand.
- 8. They say, "If we return to al-Madīnah, the more honored [for power] will surely expel therefrom the more humble." And to Allāh belongs [all] honor, and to His Messenger, and to the believers, but the hypocrites do not know.
- O you who have believed, let not your wealth and your children divert you from the remembrance of Allāh. And whoever does that – then those are the losers.
- 10. And spend [in the way of Allah] from what We have provided you before death approaches one of you and he says, "My Lord, if only You would delay me for a brief term so I would give charity and be of the righteous."
- But never will Alläh delay a soul when its time has come. And Alläh is Aware of what you do.

- 1. Whatever is in the heavens and whatever is on the earth is exalting Allāh.¹⁶⁹² To Him belongs dominion, and to Him belongs [all] praise, and He is over all things competent.
- 2. It is He who created you, and among you is the disbeliever, and among you is the believer. And Allāh, of what you do, is Seeing.
- 3. He created the heavens and earth in truth and formed you and perfected your forms; and to Him is the [final] destination.
- 4. He knows what is within the heavens and earth and knows what you conceal and what you declare. And Allah is Knowing of that within the breasts.
- 5. Has there not come to you the news of those who disbelieved before? So they tasted the bad consequence of their affair, and they will have a painful punishment.
- 6. That is because their messengers used to come to them with clear evidences, but they said, "Shall human beings guide us?" and disbelieved and turned away. And Allah dispensed [with them]; and Allāh is Free of need and Praiseworthy.

7. Those who disbelieve have claimed that they will never be resurrected. Say, "Yes, by my you will surely be Lord. resurrected; then you will surely be informed of what you did. And that, for Allah, is easy."

- 8. So believe in Allāh and His Messenger and the light [i.e., the Our'anl which We have sent down. And Allah is Aware of what you do.
- 9. The Day He will assemble you for the Day of Assembly - that is the Day of Deprivation. 1693 And whoever believes in Allah and does righteousness - He will remove from him his misdeeds and admit him to gardens beneath which rivers flow, wherein they will abide forever. That is the great attainment.
- 10. But the ones who disbelieved and denied Our verses - those are the companions of the Fire, abiding eternally therein; and wretched is the destination.
- 11. No disaster strikes except by permission of Allāh. And whoever believes in Allāh – He will guide his heart. And Allāh is Knowing of all things.
- 12. And obey Allāh and obey the Messenger; but if you turn away then upon Our Messenger is only [the duty of] clear notification.

Sūrah at-Talāq¹⁶⁹⁶

Bismillāhir-Rahmānir-Raheem

- 1. O Prophet, when you [Muslims] divorce women, divorce them for [the commencement of] their waiting period and keep count of the waiting period, 1697 and fear Allāh, your Lord. Do not turn them out of their [husbands'] houses, nor should they [themselves] leave [during that period] unless they are committing a clear immorality. And those are the limits [set by] Allāh. And whoever transgresses the limits of Allah has certainly wronged himself. You know not; perhaps Allāh will bring about after that a [different] matter. 1698
- 2. And when they have [nearly] fulfilled their term, either retain them according to acceptable terms or part with them according to acceptable terms. And bring to witness two just men from among vou and establish the testimony for [the acceptance of] Allāh. That is instructed to whoever should believe in Allah and the Last Day. And whoever fears Allāh – He will make for him a way out1699

3. And will provide for him from where he does not expect. And whoever relies upon Allāh - then He is sufficient for him. Indeed. Allāh will accomplish His purpose. Allāh has already set for everything a [decreed] extent.

- 4. And those who no longer expect menstruation among your women if you doubt, then their period is three months, and [also for] those who have not menstruated. And for those who are pregnant, their term is until they give birth.¹⁷⁰⁰ And whoever fears Allāh - He will make for him of his matter ease.
- 5. That is the command of Allah. which He has sent down to you; and whoever fears Allah - He will remove for him his misdeeds and make great for him his reward.
- 6. Lodge them¹⁷⁰¹ [in a section] of where you dwell out of your means and do not harm them in order to oppress them.¹⁷⁰² And if they should be pregnant, then spend on them until they give birth. And if they breastfeed for you, then give them their payment and confer among yourselves in the acceptable way; but if you are in discord, then there may breastfeed for him [i.e., the father] another woman. 1703

wives better than you – submitting [to Allāh], believing, devoutly obedient, repentant, worshipping, and traveling ¹⁷⁰⁸ – [ones] previously married and virgins.

- 6. O you who have believed, protect yourselves and your families from a Fire whose fuel is people and stones, over which [appointed] angels, harsh and severe; they do not disobey Allāh in what He commands them but do what they are commanded.
- 7. O you who have disbelieved, make no excuses that Day. You will only be recompensed for what you used to do.
- 8. O you who have believed, repent to Allah with sincere repentance. Perhaps¹⁷⁰⁹ your Lord remove from you your misdeeds and admit you into gardens beneath which rivers flow [on] the Day when Allah will not disgrace the Prophet and those who believed with him. Their light will proceed before them and on their right; they will say, "Our Lord, perfect for us our light and forgive us. Indeed, You are over all things competent."
- 9. O Prophet, strive against the disbelievers and the hypocrites and be harsh upon them. And their refuge is Hell, and wretched is the destination.
